Topics from Agents:

1. An up-date on having on-line boat registrations.

This would be a complex and expensive project for IF&W and is not planned at this time. IF&W thinks this is a good idea and would love to do it but the funding is not there to do it at this time.

2. Concerned that when a transaction is voided that the agent fee is not reversed. The agent fee remains on the reports, but the State fee is reversed.

Dale Freise will poll all MOSES agents to see how many of them would like to see the agent fee returned on a void. There are many cases where the agent fee would not be returned on a void (for example if the customer made a mistake in what they ordered). If we find that the majority of MOSES users want the agent fee returned to the customer on a void, we will change the system.

3. Requests for a flag to prompt agents when no excise tax has been entered for a boat registration. A pop-up reminder.

We will make this change.

4. Any news on TRIO cash receipts interfacing with MOSES?

The testing of this feature turned up a problem that is currently being worked on by our programming group. It has turned out to be a difficult problem but they are still working on it.

5. Are there any L.D.s in the Legislature that will affect agents? Any L.D.s that agents should be aware of?
